COMMERCIAL APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE

The undersigned (hereinafter called the Applicant) hereby applies for membership in and agrees to purchase electric energy from Webster Electric Cooperative (hereinafter called the Cooperative), upon the following terms and conditions.

1. All small commercial accounts, if accepted for membership, require a deposit equal to two month's estimated bill or \$200, which ever is greater (\$10.00 of which will constitute the service connection fee, with the remainder considered as a service deposit). For new small commercial construction, a contractor with a satisfactory credit history with the cooperative requires a \$100 deposit (\$10.00 of which will constitute the applicant's service connection fee, and \$90.00 of which shall constitute the service deposit). Deposits for large commercial accounts are figured on an individual account basis.
2. The Applicant will purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the premises described below and will pay therefore monthly at rates to be determined from time to time in accordance with the bylaws of the Cooperative; provided, however, that the Cooperative may limit the amount of electric energy to be furnished for industrial uses. The Applicant will pay at least the monthly availability regardless of the number of kilowatt hours consumed.
3. The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Cooperative.
4. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the charter and bylaws of the Cooperative, and such rules and regulations as may from time to time be adopted by the Cooperative.
5. The Applicant, by becoming a member, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for any debt or liabilities of the Cooperative, and it is expressly understood that under the law his private property is exempt from execution for any such debts or liabilities.
6. The Applicant is hereby aware and acknowledges that it is unlawful by Missouri Statute 56.080 to tamper with the electrical distribution equipment, including a meter, for the purpose of diverting, interrupting, or improperly measuring electrical power. If a member is found to have stolen electricity, before service is restored an additional \$500 security deposit will be required.
